The STAR Events Online Project Summary Form is required for each STAR event completed. The form can be found in the Resources section of the National Affiliation Portal. This form helps to summarize the project itself, the outreach efforts, etc. Please note that this is required for State Leadership Conference, in addition to National Leadership Conference. Your members will need to complete this prior to SLC and include in their presentation/display. If moving onto NLC, the students will need to be sure to submit a new form if there is updated information.

Online STAR Events

Digital Stories for Change and FCCLA Chapter Website are two STAR events that can be completed online. This is an opportunity for your students to compete virtually, at home. Recognition for these events will be at the 2018 National Leadership Conference, these are not state-sponsored events. Registration for both events opens December 1 in the National FCCLA Affiliation Portal. Deadline to complete the events is February 1, 2018. The fee to enter these Level I STAR Events is \$20.
