Eligibility: All high school seniors who are participants of a CTE program graduating between January and June of 2018, who are U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents and who attend public, parochial, or independent schools, as well as those who are home-schooled, are eligible. Students should have a strong record of demonstrating Academic Rigor, Technical Competence, Employability Skills, and Ingenuity & Creativity
